On Thursday July 30th, members of the Mission held a meeting with Fr. Cesar Novoa, parish priest of “The Mercy”.

The Mercy is a rural parish of the Metropolitan District of Quito, in a town located 25 km south east of the capital, in the Valley of Chillos. It has a population of 8,300 inhabitants, mostly Catholics.

The Home Enthronement Program of Our Lady of Guadalupe was explained in detail to Fr. Cesar Novoa and he was very excited to come to know that She is our Patroness because he is very devoted to Her and sees in

his Program a means to reach deeper into the Catholic faithful of his parish. He manifested he will gladly support and bless our work in the parish and invited the members of the Mission to participate in a Sunday Mass to begin approaching the parishioners.

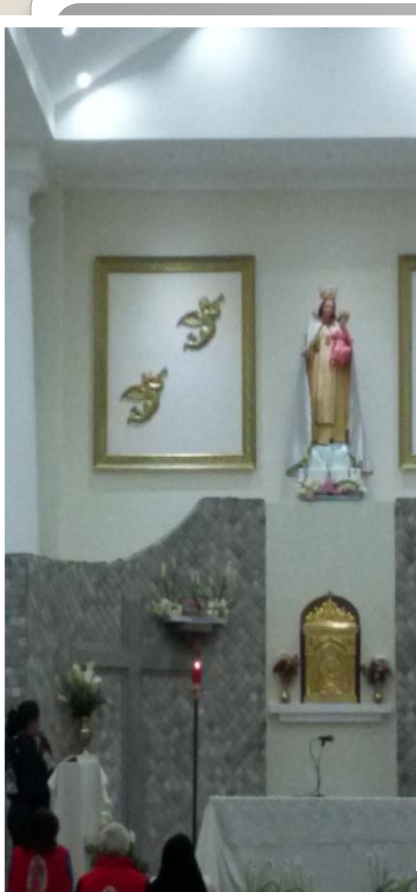
He also requested the Mission to join efforts with the work that the Movement John XXIII and the Dominican Sisters are already carrying out. Thus several meetings were held to better explain the enthronement program. Fr. Cesar also manifested his hope that the Mission might approach the parents of the children attending catechism in the future.

HOME VISITS IN THE RURAL PARISH OF “THE MERCY”

The Holy Mass to send off the missionaries was celebrated by Msgr. Miguel Angel Aguilar, former military bishop of Ecuador, who is very fond of the Mission because of the work done in conjunction with him in the past for the consecration of several police and military detachments.

Currently the Mission, together with the members of the Movement John XXIII, is carrying out the home visits in the following neighborhoods: Curiquingue, Las Palmeras and Bellavista.





On Wednesday September 16th, began the training for the Homes Visits Program at the Parish of The Spring.

The talk was given by Hernando Martinez who explained the main aspects of the Home Enthronement Program and then established the procedures to follow in each of the home visits.

Three groups of missionaries have been formed, who will proceed to contact the families that have requested to be visited, in order to agree on the dates and time for the visits.



TRAINING AT THE PARISH OF “THE SPRING”

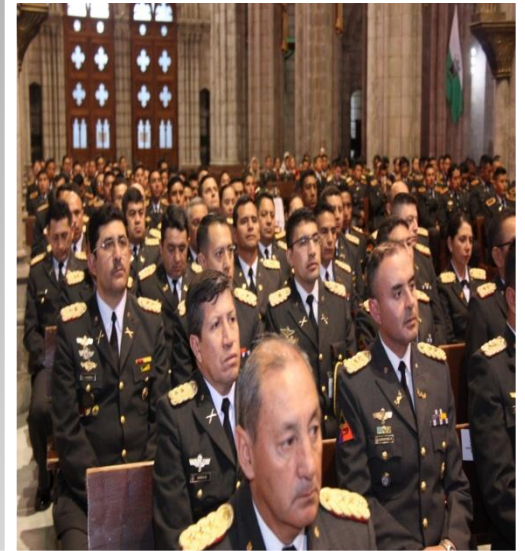
Three years ago, on Thursday September 24th 2012, there was a massive attendance for the celebration of the Enthronement of Our Lady of Guadalupe and the Consecration of the Armed Forces and the National Police to the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary.

This September 24th we wanted to celebrate the third anniversary of such an important event for the Catholic life of Ecuador which is why the Mission invited the high command of the Armed Forces and the National Police to participate in the Solemn Ceremony of Renewal. The latter was presided by Msgr. Rene Coba Galarza, Military Bishop of Ecuador who blessed the lives, jobs and families of the great number of military and police that attended this act of profound Catholic faith.

The Mission For the Love of God Worldwide handed memorable plaques of the ceremony to the commanders of the Armed Forces and the National Police.

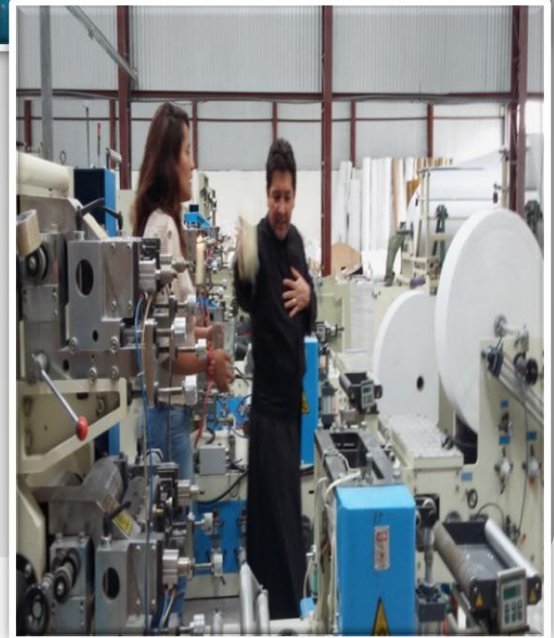

The Basilica of the National Vow through its parish priest, Fr. Jose Fabian Camayo and a group of committed Catholics, the Soldiers of the Merciful Love of Jesus and Mary and the Mission For the Love of God Worldwide, presented their initiative to Msgr. Fausto Travez, Archbishop of Quito, to celebrate a Solemn Eucharist to beg for God's help. It concluded with the procession in which a great number of faithful participated, including different Catholic groups, religious from various congregations as well as civil and military delegations that walked with much fervor through the streets of the historic center of Quito.

And so it was that on Sunday October 11th, the Archbishop and Primate of Ecuador, Msgr. Fausto

Travez, convened the Institutions of the Armed Forces, the Police, Firemen and Civil Defense as well as the Catholic groups and Catholics in general to the GREAT PRAYERFUL PROCESSION in view of the great natural, social and material threats that encircle Ecuador and the world. It began with the Solemn Mass at the Basilica of the National Vow and continued on the streets of downtown Quito, accompanied by the sculpture of Our Lady of "Panecillo".

This procession was presided by the cortege of the Fire Department who escorted the original image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus while the Catholic groups escorted the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe at the

front of the crowd.

In each mystery of the Rosary that was prayed during the procession we asked for:

1. Rain, so the distressing drought and its grave consequences for Ecuador might come to an end.
2. The fearsome outcome that an eruption of the Volcano Cotopaxi might cause.
3. The possible devastating effects of El Niño in the coasts.
4. The economical and social situation in Ecuador and the whole world.
5. The serious situation with the massive migration worldwide.
6. The terrorism and bloodless wars that are taking place worldwide.
7. The restoration of moral values in the families and in society.
8. Asking the Sacred Heart and the Immaculate Heart to fulfill their promises of protection to all the people and countries that have consecrated to them, remembering that Ecuador is the first country that was consecrated to the Two Hearts.
9. Near the end of the procession, a light drizzle came that filled all of the participants with hope and enthusiasm.



On October 31st and November 1st, the young people and adults of the Catholic group 'Missionaries of the Most Loving Hearts of Jesus and Mary' and the Mission For the Love of God Worldwide made a vigil of reparation for Halloween and intercession of the Saints.

This vigil was held from October 31st at 6:00 p.m. until 7:00 am on November 1st and the members of the apostolate 'Mary's Contemplatives' also joined.

The 12 adults that were present led the vigil since 6:00 p.m. until midnight and from that time on it was led by the youth.

The Blessed Sacrament was exposed throughout the entire vigil in which several teachings and topics were imparted along with songs of praise and moments of silent contemplation.

REPARATION VIGIL FOR HALLOWEEN



In September, the Mission For the Love of God Worldwide, invited the public entities of the Metropolitan Police and Fire Corps of the Metropolitan District of Quito to consecrate their institutions to the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary and to Enthroner our Lady of Guadalupe.

In November Colonel Juan Zapata, CEO of the Metropolitan Security, answered the request manifesting his desire to consecrate both institutions. He also asked that its members would receive a guide, always based on the four cornerstones of the Mission,

so all the activities they carry out, personal as well as professional, may be always aimed at fulfilling God's commandments through the intercession of the Virgin Mary.

Thus, on Monday November 9th, 2015, a talk was given to the firefighters of the Metropolitan District of Quito in the auditorium of their main headquarters and on Tuesday November 10th, to the Metropolitan Police, also in the auditorium of their headquarters.

The Eucharist of Consecration and Enthronement will take place on January 2016.

On November 16th, Alejandro Rivadeneira, General Manager of Rumiñahui Bank, contacted the Mission in view of the upcoming anniversary of the consecration of the Bank.

of ladies of the parish who shall begin the Home Visits.

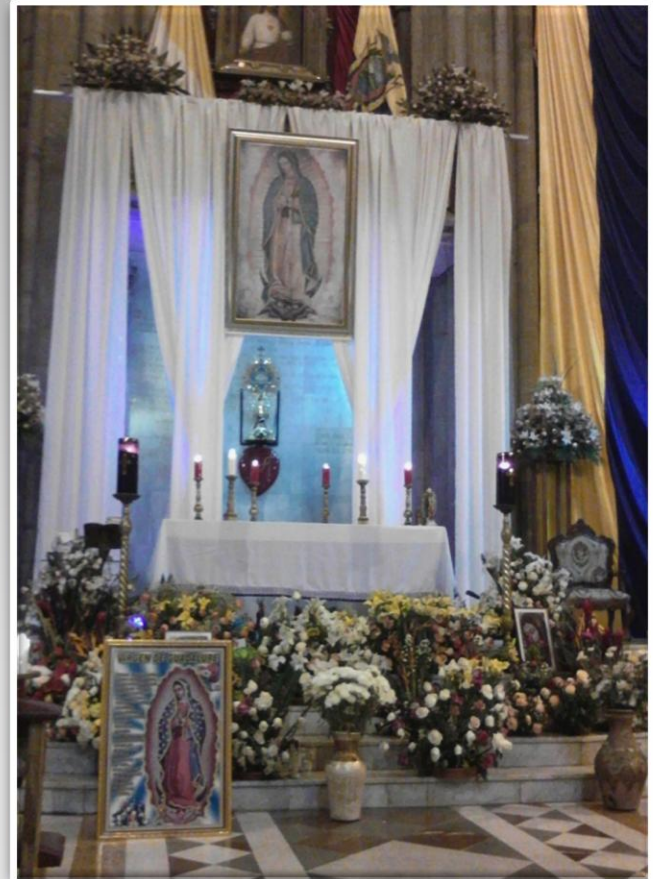

EVE OF THE FEAST OF OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE CEREMONY



On December 12th at the Basilica of Voto Nacional, a Holy Mass in honor of our Lady of Guadalupe took place. This ceremony was held before the Relic Image brought from Mexico by members of the MISSION FOR THE LOVE OF GOD WORLDWIDE and enthroned in this sanctuary on 24 September of 2012.

We began with the procession through the historical center of Quito at 3:00 p.m. with the Pilgrim Image of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

At five o'clock, the Image entered through the South Gate of the Basilica, escorted by the Knights of the Virgin, and was placed on the Altar by the members of the Guadeloupians who organized the ceremony.

Monsignor René Coba, military Bishop and Secretary of the Episcopal Conference of Ecuador, presided the ceremony. A representation of Bishop Juan de Zumárraga

and his obedience to the request of the Blessed Virgin Mary to fulfill her will, and of Juan Diego took place. Bishop Coba referred to Juan Diego as "the humble servant of Mary", who was able to be the instrument of such a great event that it changed the history of mankind; and encouraged all the attendees to be like "Juan Diego" in his humility, simplicity and obedience.

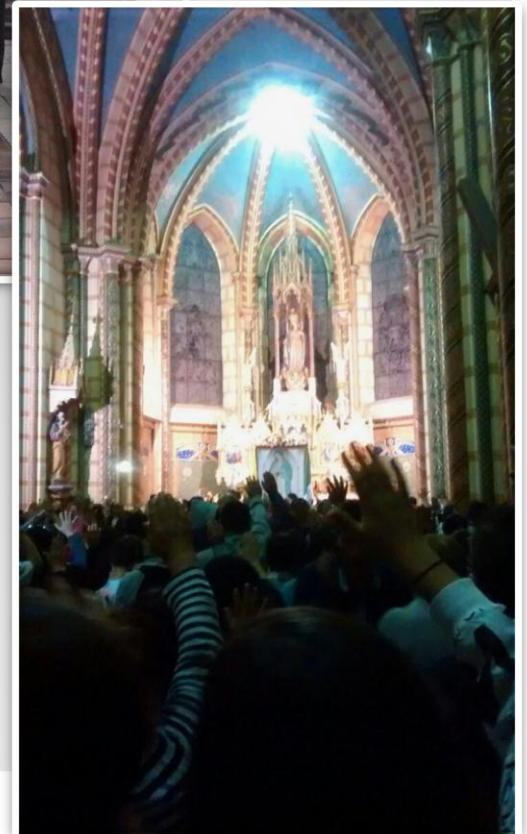
At the end of Mass, the procession continued within the Sanctuary headed by Monsignor Coba and the Pilgrim image where he

proceeded to open the DOOR OF MERCY, being the Blessed Sacrament exposed.

The opening of the Door of Mercy was symbolically done with a hammer hitting the door 3 times, to indicate that those who enter through it will receive mercy and special blessings and plenary INDULGENCES for a year.

During this year, we should perform acts of mercy and service; each one of us should bless the doors we go through, especially the ones of each home.





The Mission For the Love of God Worldwide, started on December 2nd the Novena to the Blessed Virgin of Guadalupe la Merced Parish.

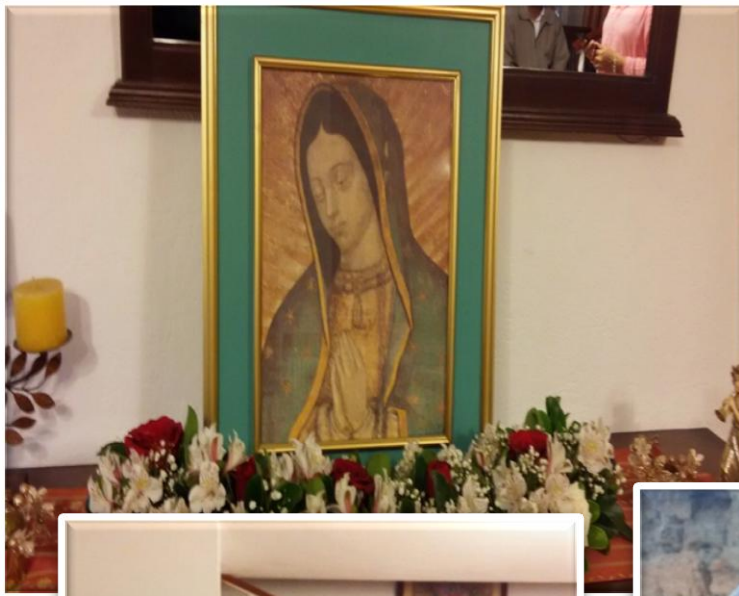
Along with the daily prayer of the Mission's Rosary, they visited a very vulnerable group of the parish, i.e., the elderly.

NOVENA TO OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE AND VISIT TO THE ELDERLY OF LA MERCED PARISH



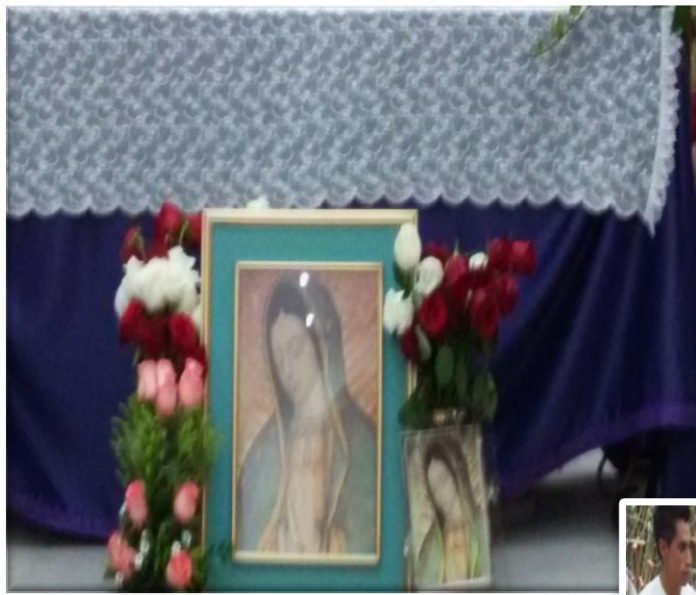

At the end toys and food were given to a total of 564 children and elder people.

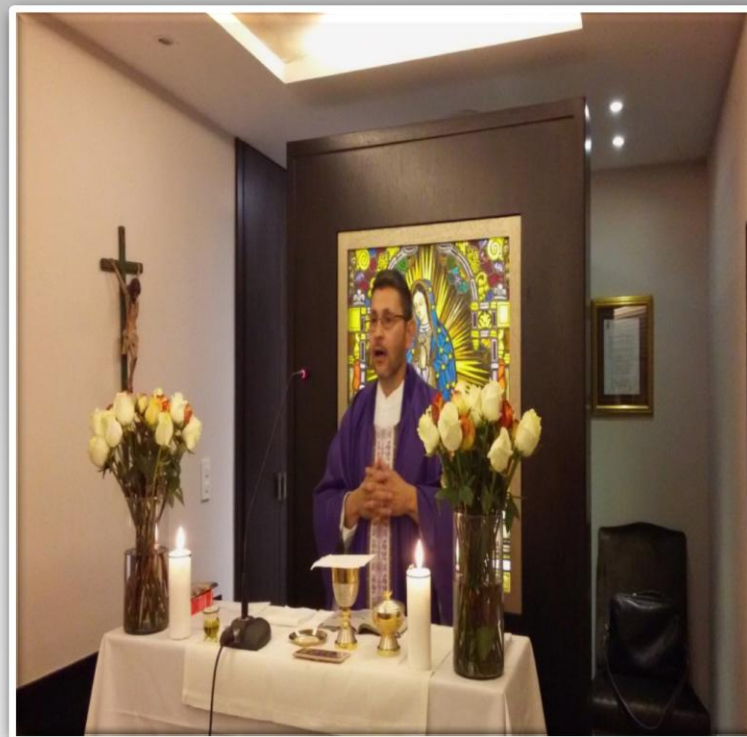
CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION WITH THE CHILDREN AND ELDERLY OF CAYAMBE
